- * Applications for the Leadership Jones County (LJC) 30th Reunion Class are requested from any graduate of Leadership Jones County.
- * Applications are reviewed, and delegates are selected by a committee. The number of delegates is limited to encourage maximum participation. Efforts are made to balance participants according to business and professional interest, geography, race and sex.
- * Tuition for the program is \$350. This includes opening ice-breaker, dinner and retreat, monthly training sessions, instructional materials and the graduation luncheon. Limited scholarship assistance is available at the discretion of the Leadership Committee. The tuition or scholarship fee must be paid-in-full prior to the opening ice-breaker session.
- * By submitting an application to the LJC Reunion program, the applicant is indicating his/her willingness and ability to attend the ice-breaker and dinner, retreat, all monthly sessions and graduation luncheon. The LJC Reunion program begins with an Ice-Breaker/Orientation and dinner on November 14th, opening Retreat on November 15th. In addition, monthly, full-day sessions, on the third Wednesday of each month will be held beginning on January 15th, February 19th, March 18th and April 15th. The program culminates with a graduation luncheon on May 6th.
- * The employer of the applicant must agree to allow the participant the time off in order to participate in the program. (*ice-breaker/orientation, retreat, monthly sessions, and graduation*)
- * Applicants must have graduated from Leadership Jones County, be a resident of Jones County, and/or employed in Jones County.

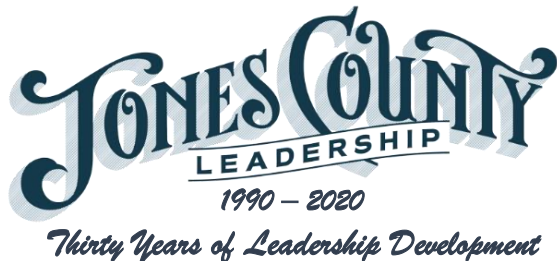

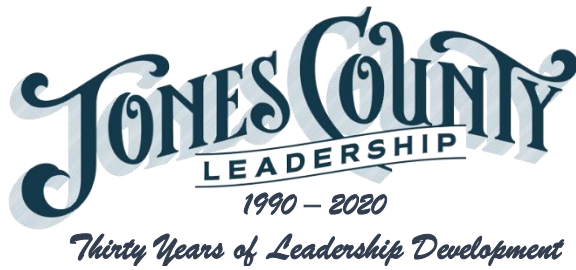
